Safety around school

If your child travels to school on their bike or scooter, please remind them of the need to ride carefully around drives and the roads. A neighbour has been to school to express concern that children are riding down his road without showing awareness of other road users.

busy at these times and it is not safe for children to be darting across from parent cars in front of other traffic.
