Parent Volunteers' Group

We have also received positive feedback this week from parents who have visited different high schools and come across our ex-pupils who had been chosen to show prospective parents around. It is always lovely to hear that the core values that we grow in our pupils go with them when they leave.

Promoting Green Behaviour Project One stop



Our School Council met for the first time this week and have launched themselves into this project. It has started thanks to a generous award from One Stop Community's Carriers for Causes grant of £516. With this we have purchased 6 paper recycling bins to distribute around school so that paper can be recycled more effectively by the children and staff. The school council are monitoring the use of the bins to make sure that they have positioned them in the best sites possible and we look forward to reporting to you later in the term how the project is going.

This will be particularly true for Year 1 and Reception children to make sure that they are in the appropriate phonics groups and Y4 to determine the knowledge that they have of times tables facts.
