New way of invoicing

We are trialling a new form of invoicing for our Out of School Club provision. From now on, we will be sending an email to parents stating the total of their invoice for the month. This will come at the normal time that the invoices have always been sent.

Nursery September 2020 – Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> April

If you have a child that you would like to start in Nursery in September, please ensure that you have completed your Nursery application form and handed it in to school by 23<sup>rd</sup> April.

We will allocate sessions soon after this date and any applications received after 23<sup>rd</sup> April will be treated as late applications and will therefore have sessions allocated after the others.

Informing school of absence

Please ensure that you inform school when your child is absent. This can be through the text messaging service, through email or by leaving a message on the answer machine. Once the registers have been taken, we check that we have received an explanation for all absent children. Where we have not received an explanation, we try to contact parents via all the numbers that we have.

For this process to work, we need to ensure that we always have accurate and up to date numbers for key contacts for your child. Please ensure that if you change your phone or the emergency contacts for your child change theirs that you let us know.

It is also important though that you inform us of reasons for absence. If we haven't received notification, we have a duty to do all that we can to ensure that the child is safe. This includes carrying out a home visit to ensure that the child is safe. If we cannot locate the child, and we are concerned, we would then contact the local police. There have been instances locally where children have

been at home when their parents or carers have become very ill or have, in the worst circumstances, died. It is therefore vital that we hear from you to confirm your child's absence.

Your help in this is very much appreciated.
