Reading

Using your **Holes text**, read two chapters each day – annotate each paragraph with a few words to summarise each.

Make a list of any new vocabulary you come across and write the definitions (using an online dictionary if you don't have one at home).

Maths basic practice

The maths activities sent home should be enough for two weeks' work (up to Easter), however, there are a few more activities below. 1) Find the mean (average) age of all the people in your house. You do this by adding up all the ages and then dividing by the number of people. You could find the mean in years and also in months. 2) Create 10 BIDMAS calculations that have the answer 20. Try to use all of the elements of BIDMAS (Brackets, Indices, Division, Multiplication, Addition, Subtraction) 3) Try Activity 54 - 'Joins' from the 'Puzzles and Problems for year 5 and 6' booklet - the Qs & As are both uploaded to the website.

Keep a diary throughout the school closure of an event that happens each day – one sentence or a longer piece, a print out of a story or a cutting from a newspaper

Break for lunch – develop your child's independence by involving them in the preparing of lunch, clearing away and washing up etc. For younger children, talk about numbers and fractions in real contexts e.g. how many halves of sandwiches do we have etc
