Book Fair

We have a book fair in school next week but obviously it will need to run differently this time as parents cannot come into school.

Today, each class in school has been able to have a look at the books in the book fair with classes going one class at a time. Each child will bring home an order form that has all the books on it tonight so that if a child has seen a book that they like, they can ask an adult at home if they are able to purchase it.

If you would like to order a book, you can return the order form with the payment and we will make sure that the child gets the book. Alternatively, you can make a payment over the phone. Details of the school code are on the paper copy of the order form that the children will have brought home (26800599). If more people order a particular book than we have copies, we are able to order these books and so your child will still get the book although there may be a little delay.

We have been able to replace our atlases, dictionaries and thesauri with the commission from these book fairs as well as improving our stock of books in classrooms and so we would really encourage you to order a book if you are able.
