### **News from this week**

#### Children In Need

Thank you for supporting Children in Need by donating money for your children to wear non-uniform. A special mention should go to some of our children who donated their own money to the collection. This really reflects our school values of fairness and respect. The total amount raised was £310.

#### Nasal Flu Vaccinations

The School Nursing Team will be in school on 1<sup>st</sup> December to administer these. They have confirmed that they are working on their schedules to fit classes across the borough who have been isolating when they have taken place and so will return for children in Switzerland later in the term.

### **Other information**

#### Free School Meals applications

We are aware that there are lots of families whose circumstances in terms of employment have changed during lockdown and the pandemic. This may mean that your child is eligible for Free School Meals which in turn means that the school would receive nearly £2000 a year as Pupil Premium funding for your child. This is funding in addition to the money that we would get to pay for the actual free meal.

The application process is easy – you just need to complete the form attached and all information about children who are eligible for Free School Meals is obviously kept confidential.

#### Christmas Festivities

We are determined to ensure that children still have a lovely end of term with lots of Christmas events even though we still can't mix together in year groups and have lots of restrictions in place.

Christmas tree festival – All the teams in school are busy secretly preparing items for a Christmas tree festival. Each class and group of staff is designing a Christmas tree around a theme and will have positioned these in shared areas and corridors by the end of next week. We will then timetable each class a session where they will walk around the school to have a look at all the trees. We will take photos of all the trees and produce a survey which we'll send out to you all so that you can vote on your favourite tree as the winning class within each age band will earn clan points.

Christmas jumper day – We will still be holding our Christmas Jumper day on the last day of term with money

donated going to Save the Children and the children will also have their Christmas dinner on this day. We will stagger lunchtime on this day so that all children will be able to eat in the hall with lots of cleaning in between each sitting. This means that Y5/6 may not be eating until 1pm so please send them with a snack to eat late morning so that we don't have lots of grumbling stomachs! If your child doesn't normally have a school dinner and they would like a Christmas dinner, please let the school office know.

Christmas cards – Children can still bring Christmas cards into school. Each class will have their own box to place these in. All cards will need to be in school by 11<sup>th</sup> December and then they will be sorted and delivered during the last week of term when they have been quarantined.

Christmas Nativity – The EYFS children are busy learning their songs for the Christmas Nativity and will be doing a series of videos over the last 2 weeks of term with each class doing 2 parts each. We will share these via class dojo.

Christmas Raffle – We will be sending your child home with a sheet of raffle tickets today.
