9.30am – A long time ago, when the world was quite new, a monkey sat watching the birds as they flew. Like feathery rainbows they flashed through the air. “How come they’re so pretty?” he thought. “It’s not fair!” When mischievous monkey discovers a paintbox, he has a brilliant idea, but things don’t go quite as monkey has planned...

(KS1 suitability)

9.50am - Michael Recycle is back! Meet Litterbug Doug. He HATES recycling! Join Michael and help him save the planet in another brilliant adventure.

(EYFS – Y3 suitability)

10.10am - Are you ready for an adventure? You are? Good. Imagine if one day you woke up and all the grown-ups had vanished. That’s what happened to LUCY DUNGSTON. She’s the hero of this story (but she doesn’t know it yet). While the rest of the children in Lucy’s town are running wild, she’s coming up with a plan to find out what’s going on. Then, late one night, Lucy spots four mysterious creatures creeping around her bedroom: GRUNT, GUFF, SNATCH and SNIFF. They are THE CREAKERS. And they know exactly what’s going on. Welcome to the mysterious world under your bed ...

(KS2 suitability)

10.30am - A noisy bum is causing trouble! It's making poops and burps and clangs! Can the noises be put to good use?

10.50am - Pax and Peter have been inseparable ever since Peter rescued him as a cub. But when Peter is forced to return his fox to the wild, his world is torn apart. Despite the encroaching war, and the three hundred miles between them, Peter sets out to find his fox. Meanwhile, Pax waits hopefully for his boy. A powerful story about the unbreakable bond between a boy and his fox.

(UKS2 suitability)

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11.10am – The enormous crocodile is the greediest creature in the whole jungle and he loves eating children! He's a terrible boaster and thinks he's really smart with his secret plans and clever tricks. But he's not as clever as the other animals and they plan to ruin his wicked schemes and teach him a lesson he won't forget.

11.30am – Plop is a beautiful baby barn owl, perfect in almost every way, except for just ONE thing... Plop is afraid of the dark!

11.50am - Being little isn't always easy. But when Mouse sets off on a journey to find his roar, he discovers that even the smallest creature can have the heart of a lion.

1pm - Meet Bernard. He's a robot with a very unusual problem.

1.20pm - The breathtakingly beautiful story of one little girl and her five paper dolls. They were Ticky and Tacky and Jackie the Backie and Jim with two noses and Jo with the bow.

1.40pm – In space, no one can smell your POOP... Danny and dinosaur zoom up to space! But Danny has forgotten the sandwiches, and soon Dinosaur is eating everything in sight, including their rocket... Luckily, Dinosaur has a pooptastic plan to get them back to Earth...
