Remote Education

During the last few weeks of remote education, we asked an external consultant to look at our remote education offer. We have now received the report from her and the summary includes the following comments:

"The school is rightly proud of the successful 'Team Withinfields' approach to the remote learning provision. The system has been effective because the Headteacher, leaders and staff in the school have worked with pupils, parents and carers as part of a learning community. The school has sought feedback, listened and responded. It has not made assumptions or adopted a 'one size fits all' approach; rather the Headteacher has led the development of an ambitious and inclusive remote learning provision which caters for a variety of pupil's needs and styles, takes into account family circumstances and is a good fit for Withinfields School."

This positive outcome is not just down to us, as staff, but as it suggests, is also down to the pupils and your hard work as parents and carers. Thank you!

Assessments

Following time to settle back into their learning, most children in school are now being assessed in terms of their reading and phonics, maths and grammar, punctuation and spelling. This is so that we can identify any gaps that have occurred in individual children's understanding and development but also as whole classes or cohorts. We can then plan to plug these gaps and put intervention in place where specific groups or individuals have particular needs.

I know a few parents have commented that they were worried about their child's learning and we are planning to organise parent-teacher consultations after Easter so that we can update you about your individual child and you can share any concerns.

Children's Mental Health

We are aware that some children are struggling with their emotions and worries at the moment. If you have any concerns about your child, please do not hesitate to contact a member of staff in school. We have staff who are Mental Health First Aiders trained in school and can support children and their families with lots of issues.

We are continuing to offer mindfulness sessions most days in class and Mrs Lowerson is starting to run Calm Club again for a different year group each day so that bubbles don't mix. Worry boxes will also be emphasised as part of PSHE next week to remind children that if they don't feel comfortable talking about their worries, they can put a note in the box.

We would love it if you could listen to your child read every day or ask them questions about their book each day. If you take the time to do this, please let us know by writing a little note in your child's reading record.

Other information

Learning Support Opportunity in Y6

We are anticipating some additional funding for a child in Y6 and therefore if this is granted we will be looking to recruit someone on a fixed term contract for the Summer term. As the child would then leave school, I cannot confirm that there would be work available after July 2021.

Nursery for September

In the coming months, we will be starting to look at our Nursery intake for September. If you have a child that will be 3 years old by 31.8.21 please let Miss Redmond know if you would like them to have a place in our nursery. She will then be able to let you have the necessary forms to complete. Applications received after 23rd April will be treated as late applications and will be allocated sessions after all other applications have been processed.

Admissions into other year groups

We have places in most year groups due to us moving from mixed age to single aged classes a few years ago. If you know of families moving into the area, please encourage them to come and have a look around our school so that they can join us.

Lateral Flow Testing

As you will be aware, staff at school have access to lateral flow tests to test twice a week to check that they are not asymptomatic. The government are providing the same tests for households with primary aged children. The government website states:

"Tests will be available for adults in these households to collect. As with student testing, this is encouraged but not mandatory. A secondary PCR test will be required for positive lateral flow tests which are taken at home, either through at home PCR testing or at a local PCR testing site."

If you would like to use lateral flow tests within your household twice a week, they can be collected from Asda Overflow Car Park between 1pm and 8pm each day. We ask, if anyone in the household tests positive on a lateral flow test, that the whole household isolates and a PCR test is booked for the person testing positive. Following the PCR results, NHS advice should be followed.
