#### News from this week Assemblies

We have started to hold assemblies this week but with just 3 year groups in the hall instead of 7 as would normally be the case. This means that we can still keep different year groups apart from each other.

We are focusing on our learning behaviours, our core values and linking these to inspirational people and fundamental British Values this half term. We spent yesterday's assembly remembering how we MEMM (Make every moment matter). I'm sure your children can tell you about it at home and how they MEMM!

## Fire Drill

We held a fire drill yesterday to practise evacuating the building. The children were amazing and behaved so sensibly with the new arrangements whereby the year groups need to line up with spaces between them. A special well done needs to go to Nursery children though as, for those that started in January, this was the first time they had practised evacuating the building.

## Homework

We have started issuing homework for Y1-6 on Google Classrooms following the success of this platform during the last lockdown. Each child will receive English and Maths homework on there. Teachers are able to provide your child's login details if you need them.

Your child should also read every night at home, preferably to an adult, and they will receive from either this Friday or next Friday Maths Passport homework as normal on paper.

## Intra-School Sports

We have started our Intra-School Sports weekly competitions this week. Each week, we are choosing a different sport for a team from each class to compete in. The winners in each year group will earn points for their clan. This week's sport was Boccia. Each week, the sport will change and a different team will be chosen so it is vital that your child has a PE kit in school all the time in case they are chosen to represent their class in the team which is playing.

### Information for next week

#### Plugging the Gaps day

Following the lockdown, it is clear that there are some parts of the curriculum that children have missed or not fully understood during remote learning. We have therefore decided to introduce a number of 'plugging the gaps' days this term to try to address some of the specific gaps in children's learning before they move on to their new year groups. The first one will be focusing on Maths and will take place next Friday. The children will be involved in Maths activities all day with some classes building on a theme over the course of the day e.g. understanding of fractions and others choosing 4 specific skills or elements of maths that need further teaching. We are planning on making the afternoon sessions as fun as we can with practical activities, collaboration and puzzles.

By focusing on gaps in this way, it means that for the majority of the time, we can continue to offer a really broad curriculum with all the subjects included. We will evaluate how well Friday goes and then plan in other days over the course of the term.

# Parents' Evening

We are trialling our first online parents' evenings next week. All could go amazingly and without any hitches but as this is the first one we have done using zoom, it is likely that there will be hiccups! Please bear with us if things go wrong. We will obviously learn a lot from this one next week and will then know more about how best to organise it if we need to do a virtual one again.

If your meeting doesn't go ahead as planned or you get cut off for any reason, please do not worry. I have asked teachers to ring those parents within the following week.

For those parents who haven't booked an appointment, we will send out assessment information after next week so that you have still had the same information provided.

#### <u>Clubs</u>

These are starting next week. Thank you for those families that have signed up to support these. The staff are excited to be getting more back to normal! Please be aware that the car park will be closed to cars at the time when clubs are ending to ensure that safety of OOSC children moving to the Sure Start building and children leaving school at the end of clubs i.e. from 4.05pm to 4.25pm. All children attending clubs will be leaving via the hall fire door so please wait in the car park near this door but at social distance from each other until your child is handed to you.
