Please can I remind you to wear a facemask if you are able when collecting and dropping off children in case you need to have a face to face conversation with staff. If you collect children from Out of School Club, please remain in the lobby area rather than entering the school and wear a facemask as you wait in case staff are needing to leave through the lobby area. Other information

Y6 Party

Car Park Access

Please can I remind parents that they should not be parking in the car park when collecting children from extra-curricular activities as the children and parents need to walk through the car park when they have been reunited at the hall door.

Entering and leaving the premises

We have spoken to some children about jumping over the school perimeter wall in the mornings and afternoons rather than walking around. Please ensure that your

children refrain from doing this when you drop them off and pick them up as it is an essential part of our safeguarding procedures. Children are taught in school not to go on the grass when playing out so that they stay away from the wall and by encouraging your children to jump over the wall, you are putting them and other children who witness it at risk.

Nursery for September

The deadline for Nursery applications to be considered for September has passed but it is looking like the admissions are low at the moment so please recommend us if you have friends and family members who have a child who will be 3 on or before 31st August. I am happy to show people around our nursery if they would like to make an appointment.

School Uniform

Please can I remind parents about a few parts of the school uniform policy that we have noticed are not being complied with. Hair accessories should be white, black or blue and should be used to tie long hair back. Jewellery should not be worn except a wrist watch and a pair of stud earrings or a single stud earring worn in the lobe of the ear. Children should not wear make-up including nail varnish for school.

Covid-19 reminder

Please can I remind parents that if anyone in the household or childcare bubble is experiencing symptoms of covid, the whole household should isolate until a PCR test has been completed and has come back negative or, if positive, until the date provided by test and trace.

If anyone in the household completes a lateral flow test which comes back positive, this should also lead to the whole household isolating until a PCR test has been completed.

Please can I remind parents that if anyone is showing symptoms of covid-19, they should not do a lateral flow test but should book a PCR test to confirm whether they are positive. Lateral flow tests are to identify people who do not have symptoms of COVID but are contagious with the virus.

If you need to inform us of absence, please leave a message as normal at the school office. However, if the absence is due to a positive test of a child, please email myself (head@withinfields.calderdale.sch.uk) or send me a classdojo message as soon as possible so that we can work with local public health officers to determine whether we need to inform others to also self-isolate.
