Other information

Bus pass applications – September 2021

We have been provided with the following information regarding school bus pass applications.

If your child currently travels to school by bus or is due to start secondary school for the first time in September 2021 and intends to travel by bus you will need to apply for a bus pass.

Zero fare passes (renewal and new applications)

If your child is eligible for free home to school transport, you will need to apply **online** at www.calderdale.gov.uk/hometoschooltransport
Deadline to apply is 15 June 2021.

Fare payable passes (renewals and new applications)

If you would like to apply for a fare payable pass (which may be for a pass on a dedicated school bus or public service bus), you will need to apply directly to West Yorkshire Combined Authority (Metro) at www.wymetro.com The deadline to apply is 25 June 2021.

Important information:

- Any late application submitted may result in a pass not being issued in time for the start of the academic year in September 2021.
- Any pass/seat allocation is determined by West Yorkshire Combined Authority.
- No further reminders will be sent regarding bus pass applications. It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to ensure that an application is submitted in line with the noted deadlines for assessing/processing.

The deadline for Nursery applications to be considered for September has passed but it is looking like the admissions are low at the moment so please recommend us if you have friends and family members who have a child who will be 3 on or before 31st August. Covid-19 reminder

Please can I remind parents that if anyone in the household or childcare bubble is experiencing symptoms of covid, the whole household should isolate until a PCR test has been completed and has come back negative or, if positive, until the date provided by test and trace.

If anyone in the household completes a lateral flow test which comes back positive, this should also lead to the whole household isolating until a PCR test has been completed.

Please can I remind parents that if anyone is showing symptoms of covid-19, they should not do a lateral flow test but should book a PCR test to confirm whether they are positive. Lateral flow tests are to identify people who do not have symptoms of COVID but are contagious with the virus.

If you need to inform us of absence, please leave a message as normal at the school office. However, if the absence is due to a positive test of a child, please email myself (head@withinfields.calderdale.sch.uk) or send me a classdojo message as soon as possible so that we can work with local public health officers to determine whether we need to inform others to also self-isolate.
