Lottery

Many thanks for everyone's support with the lottery this last few weeks. Forest Schools

Mrs Barton and Mr Todd have completed extensive training this term in the delivery of forest school activities. To be accredited as Forest School Practitioners, they will now deliver activities with a small group of children over the course of the year in our wildlife area and will be assessed during and at the end of the year. Once they have completed their accreditation, we are hoping to extend the provision to wider groups of children to make better use of our outdoor environment and develop children's confidence, self-esteem and character. We are really excited about this new venture for Withinfields.

Book Fair

The Book Fair will be arriving in school next week. As we have done in recent times, we will send the children home with a leaflet including all the books that are available so that parents can order using the form and either sending in cash or paying through our school gateway. We will make sure that each class has had chance to look through the book shelves during school time so that they can bring home ideas of books that they may like to purchase.

We will also open the book fair for families to browse through the shelves after school on Thursday and Friday next week and on Monday and Tuesday the week after. If you wish to do this, please collect your children as normal and then wait by the hall fire door. Once the staff running the book fair have finished releasing their children, they will come and open the book fair in the hall.

Open Morning and Evening

We are holding an open morning and open evening on Wednesday, 17th November at 9.30am and at 7pm. These events are for families who are making decisions about which schools to select for children starting school in September 2022. They will have the opportunity to hear from myself about our school community, the chance to look around the school and meet some staff so that they hopefully get a feel for our school ethos and atmosphere.

If you know of any families with children who will be 4 on or before 31st August, please encourage them to come along to find out about our school. We know that you, as our existing parents, are our best ambassadors so appreciate you passing on this information where relevant.

Staff Vacancies

We are currently looking to employ an additional midday supervisor to work at school. The hours would be from 12noon to 1pm. The role involves a range of tasks but may include: supervising the children in the playground, organising activities in the playground for children to engage in, supervising and supporting children in the hall and cleaning the hall during and after the children have eaten. Current Local Advice for COVID-19 cases

Although latest data from Calderdale Public Health is showing that the number of cases is reducing, they are recommending the following guidance for the next few weeks for children with positive cases in their household. If someone in the household has tested positive for COVID-19 (on LFD or PCR), Calderdale Public Health advise children and young people who attend school to stay at home. If they develop symptoms, they should get a PCR test straight away. If they don't have symptoms, they should get a PCR test 3-5 days after their household member started with symptoms (or took their test if they had no symptoms). If this test is negative, the child can return to school but must stay at home and arrange another test if they go on to develop symptoms. While they are away from school, we are able to class them as X in our register which means that they are off school because they are following Public Health advice and it doesn't affect their overall attendance figures.

Parents/carers who still want their child to continue to attend school have the right for them to do so. Calderdale Public Health would, however, still strongly advise getting a PCR for their child before they return. Reducing the risk of transmission is important for health reasons but also is important to reduce the overall disruption to education.
