Although it is lovely to have our 'good' school confirmed by Ofsted, it is more important to us that you, as our parents and carers, are happy with our school.

Remembrance

The school held an act of remembrance in the playground on Thursday at 11am following a video introduction in their classroom. The children behaved with respect for those being remembered. We were very proud of them all.

Achievement Beyond the Curriculum

Open Morning and Evening

We are holding an open morning and open evening on Wednesday, 17th November at 9.30am and at 7pm. These events are for families who are making decisions about which schools to select for children starting school in September 2022. They will have the opportunity to hear from myself about our school community, the chance to look around the school and meet some staff so that they hopefully get a feel for our school ethos and atmosphere.

Staff Vacancies

We are currently looking to employ an additional midday supervisor to work at school. The hours would be from 12noon to 1pm. The role involves a range of tasks but may include: supervising the children in the playground, organising activities in the playground for children to engage in, supervising and supporting children in the hall and cleaning the hall during service and after the children have eaten. The post involves a range of tasks and responsibilities including: serving the children a snack and clearing away afterwards, organising activities for the children to engage in, supervising children during these activities and their play to ensure that they are safe and behave appropriately, creating a safe, caring, happy environment for the children and communicating effectively with parents and carers when handing children over to them. Current Local Advice for COVID-19 cases

Although latest data from Calderdale Public Health is showing that the number of cases is reducing, they are recommending the following guidance for the next few weeks for children with positive cases in their household. If someone in the household has tested positive for COVID-19 (on LFD or PCR), Calderdale Public Health advise children and young people who attend school to stav at home. If they develop symptoms, they should get a PCR test straight away. If they don't have symptoms, they should get a PCR test 3-5 days after their household member started with symptoms (or took their test if they had no symptoms). If this test is negative, the child can return to school but must stay at home and arrange another test if they go on to develop symptoms. While they are away from school, we are able to class them as X in our register which means that they are off school because they are following Public Health advice and it doesn't affect their overall attendance figures.

Parents/carers who still want their child to continue to attend school have the right for them to do so. Calderdale Public Health would, however, still strongly advise getting a PCR for their child before they return. Reducing the risk of transmission is important for health reasons but also is important to reduce the overall disruption to education.
