Bun donations

Please can I remind parents and carers that we cannot accept buns and cakes made at home for the bun sale each Friday due to the potential for transmission of Covid-19. We are very grateful for donations of buns, biscuits, donuts, cookies etc which are packaged though!

Current Local Advice for COVID-19 cases

Although latest data from Calderdale Public Health is showing that the number of cases is reducing, they are recommending the following guidance for the next few weeks for children with positive cases in their household.

If someone in the household has tested positive for COVID-19 (on LFD or PCR), Calderdale Public Health advise children and young people who attend school to stay at home. If they develop symptoms, they should get a PCR test straight away. If they don't have symptoms, they should get a PCR test 3-5 days after their household member started with symptoms (or took their test if they had no symptoms). If this test is negative, the child can return to school but must stay at home and arrange another test if they go on to develop symptoms. While they are away from school, we are able to class them as X in our register which means that they are off school because they are following Public Health advice and it doesn't affect their overall attendance figures.

Parents/carers who still want their child to continue to attend school have the right for them to do so. Calderdale Public Health would, however, still strongly advise getting a PCR for their child before they return. Reducing the risk of transmission is important for health reasons but also is important to reduce the overall disruption to education.
