Information for next week

Assessments

Children will be assessed next week in school. Please ensure that you try to get them to school on time so that they can settle in before they start their assessments. We will inform you of the outcomes of the assessments as soon as we have marked and collated all the results.

Other information

Parking considerately

We have received complaints from residents living on Whitley Lane as parents are blocking the road when it is pick up and drop off times. Information about the vehicles has been passed on to the local policing team. The residents have also expressed concerns about the safety of the children exiting these cars and crossing the roads. They are concerned that a child is going to get knocked down or a serious accident is going to take place.

Please ensure that you show consideration to all our neighbours around school and make sure that you supervise your children carefully when getting them in and out of the car.

In case you missed it

Local Public Health Guidance

Please note the following information from our Calderdale Public Health in terms of who they recommend for isolation and testing.

If someone in the household has tested positive for COVID-19 (on LFD or PCR), advise pupils/students to stay at home. If they develop symptoms, they should get a PCR test straight away. If they don't have symptoms, they should get a PCR test 3-5 days after their household member started with symptoms (or took their test if they had no symptoms). If this test is negative, the child can return to school but must stay at home and arrange another test if they go on to develop symptoms.

Some children are exempt from this advice:

- 12–16-year-olds who have had at least one dose of the vaccine more than 14 days ago
- Any child aged between 5 16 who has tested positive for COVID-19 via a PCR test within the past 90 days.

Parents/carers who still want their child to continue to attend school have the right for them to do so. We would, however, still strongly advise that they obtain a PCR for their child before they return.

Nativity Performance

The EYFS children are starting to practise their nativity performance ready for the last week of term. The two performances will be strictly ticket only as we have to limit the number of people in the audience to 65 at each performance. This means that each child in Nursery and Reception will be able to buy 2 tickets. Tickets will go on sale from Tuesday, 30th November. Parents wishing to purchase a ticket will need to send £2 for one ticket or £4 for two tickets in an envelope with the dates/times of the performances will take place on 15th December at 5pm and 16th December at 9.30am. Tickets will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

Secret Christmas Shop

We are holding our secret Christmas shop in the last week of term. Children are invited to book in at the shop by paying £3 per present via School Gateway or in cash in a named envelope. The payments need to be sent by Friday 10th December and the shop will run in the last week of term with children visiting the shop to choose the present that they would like to give to their loved one at home.

Christmas Tree Festival

We are holding a Christmas tree festival in school. Each class is designing and decorating a tree by next Monday and families are welcome to come to visit the trees after school on Tuesday and Wednesday next week. The price to enter is £1 per family which gives you 3 tokens to vote for your favourite trees. If you want to purchase further tokens, they will be priced at 50p a token.
