News from this week

Visit from Councillor Tremayne

Councillor Diane Tremayne visited our school on Tuesday to find out about our provision for emotional wellbeing and to chat to some children about their lives inside and outside school.

She was very impressed with the calm atmosphere around school and the lovely welcome that the children and staff gave to her. She was interested to hear about how many different sporting clubs and associations that our children are involved in outside school. The children spoke about our ethos of 'It's okay to be different' and she recognised how inclusive our school is for children with all needs including welcoming the Highbury Hub and Hive.

She recognised that we sometimes needed to consider how best to spend our budget given the finite resources that we have but was impressed with initiatives like the Enrichment Pot so that everyone had access to all trips and visits without having to worry about the cost.

She was also interested in the wellbeing research project that we are involved in and I have agreed to keep her up-to-date with progress with that.

Governors' meeting

The Governing Body met last night and welcomed a new governor to the board, Reverend Nigel Stimpson. The teaching staff with responsibility for the leadership of PE, Science and Computing shared their summary of their subjects which the governors found interesting and useful.

Movie Night

Children will watch the film that you have requested on School Gateway unless they change their mind on the night in which case, we will aim to accommodate them in the film that they choose. They will need to stay in the same film throughout the event though so that staff know who they are responsible for.

School will provide all children with popcorn and juice.
