The PLOs will be monitoring children's attendance and working with the Education Welfare Officers from Calderdale Council to ensure that children attend regularly and punctually. They will get in touch with parents of children, in the next few weeks, who were persistently absent last year so that we can ensure that this improves for 2024-25.

PE kits

Your class teachers will have informed you through ClassDojo about PE days for each class. Please ensure that your children are in correct PE kit on these days which includes:

- Plain navy or black shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings
- A white t-shirt or polo shirt (school logo optional)
- A plain navy sweatshirt or hoodie or navy sweatshirt or hoodie with the school logo
- Pumps or trainers

Nasal Flu vaccinations
