News from this week

Y6 Bikeability

We have been very lucky this year to have been chosen by Calderdale Bikeability to receive free training for our Y6 children. The trainers explain and give the children opportunity to practise cycling safely on the road. The children that have taken part already have really enjoyed the sessions.

Big School Birdwatch

The children this week have all participated in the 'Big School Birdwatch.' The school council have been wonderful at organising resources and explaining to the classes how it would work. Each class have had a session outside watching for birds in the playground or wildlife area and recording which birds they have seen. They have been given a sheet to help them to identify the different birds. All our findings will be sent off on Friday to contribute to a national database.

Information for next week

Beetle Drive

We are holding a Beetle drive on Wednesday 12th February at 4.15pm. This is a family event with parents and children joining it together. Tickets will be available via School Gateway from Monday at £2 per person attending. Children cannot attend on their own.

For those that haven't been to a Beetle Drive before, this is how it works:

Participants sit on tables of 4 with each player having their own sheet and a pencil. On each table, the players take it in turns to shake a dice. Depending on the number thrown, a part of the beetle is drawn on the paper by that player.



The tables all keep going until one player in the room has completed their beetle. They shout 'BEETLE' and everyone in the room stops playing and counts the number of body parts that they've drawn which gives them a number of points to add to their score.

The person with the highest number of points on each table moves up to the next table and the lowest scoring person moves down. This means that you get to play with different people as the session goes on. A parent may wish to play as a pair with their child at a table if they think that they may need some support.

At the end of all the rounds, the person with the highest total score is the winner. We look forward to this being an enjoyable and successful event.

What illnesses prevent my child from going to school?

We are often asked whether a child can be in school when they have an illness. Some illnesses occur without the child actually feeling poorly so it is understandable that parents feel that they are well enough to be in school. If your child feels under the weather with an illness that wouldn't stop them from attending school, and you feel that they are well enough to be in school, please bring them in. We would always call you later in the day if they deteriorated and we felt they needed to go home. We also sometimes call parents and ask if they would like us to give the child some Calpol if we feel this may help the child feel better.

If your child is not able to be in school due to illness, please contact the school office via the admin Classdojo account, telephone message, text message or email, giving a reason for absence. Please make contact every day that they are absent so that we know that they continue to be poorly.

We really appreciate the efforts that parents are making to ensure that their children are in school regularly and on time.
