Improving Attendance Information

How does Withinfields' attendance compare to national data?

The national average attendance rate for the current 2024/25 academic year to date is 93.4%. This means the average absence rate is 6.6%. Additionally, 18.1% of pupils are considered persistently absent, meaning they miss 10% or more of their possible school sessions.

Withinfields attendance rate for the current year to date is 94.3% which is above the national average and our percentage of children considered persistently absent is 16.1% which is again better than the national average.

Please can we all continue to prioritise children's attendance at school to ensure that we remain better than average by the end of the year.
