We have been incredibly proud of how hard the Year 6 children have worked this week in their Standard Attainment Tests. They have shown true resilience and determination in each of the tests and have done their very best. We are incredibly proud of each and every one of them.

Parents' events this week

It has been lovely to see so many different events taking place this week involving parents.

On Tuesday, Mrs Jordan, one of our parent liaison officers, held her regular story session for nursery children and parents or grandparents.

On Wednesday afternoon, Mrs Jordan held our launch of the 50 things to do before you're 5 project. It was lovely to have the Nursery grown ups taking part in the activities in the wildlife area. I saw some amazing photos from the event and look forward to hearing from the children about things that they've continued to tick off with their families. It was also Year 1 and 2's family learning event on Wednesday afternoon where the children and adults made a fruit salad which links to the learning that they've been doing in Design Technology. The hall had a lovely fragrant smell to it afterwards!

On Thursday, it was Year 3's family learning event where they made dough to bake their own bread. Although it looked like some of the children had got more flour on their jumpers than in the dough, I know that they all had a lovely time.

This afternoon, Germany class will be having their Stay and Play event in the forest with Mr Griffiths. At the time of writing, I know that they are all really looking forward to showing their grown-ups all the skills they have learned through their 'Forest School' sessions.

Thank you to all the parents and grandparents who have supported these events. We really appreciate the enthusiasm that you show towards these learning activities when you can accompany your children.

Trips

We have also had various educational visits taking place in the last few weeks. The Reception children had a trip to Tropical world in Leeds as part of their work looking at life cycles and living things. They had a lovely time and were fabulous young ambassadors for Withinfields.

Y5 visited York, taking part in a workshop and visiting The Jorvik Centre. This links to their History learning and again they demonstrated positive behaviour and asked sensible and relevant questions relating to what they saw and had learned.

Y3 visited Yorkshire Sculpture Park as part of their learning linked to Art and Design where they have learned about sculpture and Henry Moore. They took part in workshops and spent time looking at the various sculptures.
