The Reception children and parents enjoyed a lovely morning today sharing memories of the last year and celebrating each of the children. I know that the staff and parents were quite emotional about how far they had come! Thank you to the Reception staff for organising such a positive event.

Parental Questionnaire

Many thanks for the positive feedback via our parental questionnaire and for taking the time to look at this. We are pleased that, when compared to last year, the proportion of parents feeling that we let you know how well your child is doing has increased as we have implemented termly reports this year alongside the two parents' evenings which has obviously had a positive impact in your view. Other questions continue to be incredibly positive with over 95% of parents agreeing with most of the questions. We will focus on informing you more about what your children are learning in the new year as this is something that more of you feel that you would like.

Information for next week

Transition days

These are taking place on Wednesday and Thursday next week and all children will move into their new classes for the two days with Y6 children going on trips out of school. Please drop your child off at their new classroom door and collect them from the same place. If you are unsure where to go, please ask the members of staff at the gate.

Current Y4 will still swim on Thursday next week so please send them with their swimming kits.

Y6 children will need to walk around to the hall fire door on the transition days so that they can be registered in the hall.

Weather

Please remember to apply sun cream to your children before coming to school each day and please send them with a hat. This is particularly important for the Year 6 children as we will be walking a lot on Wednesday and Thursday and are also hoping to involve them in outdoor activities over the course of the last week.

Y6 Guard of Honour

We hold a guard of honour for the Y6 children on the last day of the year as they leave for their last time. Please can we ask that all other year groups are collected by 3pm on this last day so that we can organise the guard of honour. We will open the gates at 2.50pm for you to come to collect them.

Other information

Food options next year

We are moving to a new supplier for school dinners next year which will mean a change to the menu in September. There will not be daily sandwich or jacket potato options but there will be three different hot meal options each day so that there is likely to be an option that your child will like. Initially, the children will be choosing their food at the hatch but after a short while, we will be introducing an ordering system at morning registration so that children can choose the meal options that they would like. As mentioned in our newsletter last week, school meals will be charged at £2.75 from September onwards.

We have decided to stop offering toast next year so will only be offering buns each Friday. A payment option to pay for buns next year will be opened next week. The whole year costs £19.50 per child or just the Autumn term costs £7.50. We will be continuing the sponsorship scheme in the hope that all children can be guaranteed a bun but this still requires considerable contributions from parents to pay for their child's buns. Please remember that the money received from buns pays for every child to have a trip each year. Thank you for your support this year with this!

Holiday activities

We are aware that the summer holidays are approaching and that keeping children fed and entertained during the full six weeks can be a challenge. There are lots of opportunities available for children who are eligible for free school meals to be booked on to, many of which include a free meal at lunchtime and free activities. There are also some opportunities which particularly cater for children with Special Educational Needs. For example, Rokit on Fridays. It's definitely worth a look!
