Other information

Uniform - One of our School Improvement Priorities this year is to further develop children's sense of pride in themselves, in their work and in being a part of TeamWithinfields. Wearing our school uniform contributes to this. I just wanted to remind parents of a few points from our School Uniform policy:

- Trousers, skirts, shorts, pinafores or skorts should be grey
- Shoes should be plain black
- Polo shirts can be either navy or white (with or without the school logo)
- Jumpers and cardigans should be plain navy (with or without the school logo) and hoodies can be worn if they are plain navy with the school logo

Most children do wear appropriate uniform but we have noticed that the tidiness and appropriateness of clothing can reduce on PE days. For clarity, on PE days, children should wear:

- A plain white t-shirt (with or without the school logo) or their normal polo shirt
- Navy or black shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms (no brand logos please)
- Jumpers, cardigans or hoodies as above
- Any trainers

We already have a huge pile of jumpers, hoodies and cardigans in lost property, all of which is unnamed. PLEASE put your child's name in all uniform that they are likely to take off as well as in coats, hats etc. as items make their way back to your child when found around school then. If your child has lost jumpers, cardigans or hoodies and they were not named, please let your classteacher know what size your child is and we can provide replacements from the lost property pile. It may not be exactly the same jumper as your child lost but saves our pile growing any bigger and you buying another.

Open Day - We are planning to hold our Open Day for families that are looking to join TeamWithinfields in September 2026 on 13th November. There will be a session in the morning, one in the afternoon and another in the evening. Please pass this date on to any family, friends and neighbours who are starting to think about Nursery or Reception for next Autumn. If they are not able to attend on this day, please ask them to contact school and we can make an alternative appointment for them.
