Online safety - We have been alerted to a safeguarding concern this week by our safeguarding connections within Calderdale Council linked to a series of children's books. The books had a website listed in them for children to access for more information linked to the books but this had been taken over by an organisation which was publishing pornographic content. The issue has been resolved now but this acts as a timely reminder for all adults to have control over the websites that children are accessing via their devices at home.

Courteous parking - Please consider our neighbours and pavement users when parking near school. Please do not block driveways or garage doors and please ensure, when parking on pavements, that there is still room for double buggies to get past without having to endanger lives by being forced into the road.

SEND coffee morning - I have attached a leaflet about our SEND coffee morning which will take place on the first morning back after the holidays. It is open to any parent but particularly targeted at those parents who have children with additional needs and offers a supportive network of parents and staff as well as biscuits and a hot drink! Miss Rothery and I both attend and are available should you have questions about the provision available in school.
