**Information for parents of children with Special Educational Needs** - I have included some flyers about various services and events that may be of interest to some of you:

Max Cards - £6.00 (cash only please) can be bought in person from Unique Ways. Helping families save money on great days out at castles, zoos, bowling alleys, trampoline parks and many more. Unique Ways are designated by mymaxcard to administer the sale of Max Cards to eligible families in Calderdale (Parent Carers). Carers of Looked after children are also eligible.

**Unique Ways offer booklet -** This outlines all the different services that Unique Ways offers to support families including sleep experts, SEND navigators and general support for any family with children with Special Educational Needs. It's worth a look.

**Dad's group -** Information about a group of dads of children with Special Educational Needs that meets at Grayston Unity in Halifax once a month.

**ADHD adult support group** - Information about a group that meets once a month to offer peer support for adults with diagnosed or suspected ADHD or people that care for them.
