### Other information

**Wall and gates** - Please can parents refrain from jumping over the wall or gates and lifting children over the wall or gates. I have arranged for the gate near France's cloakroom to be opened at 8.30am and at 3pm so that those who find it easier to walk through the car park to pick up from France can get through. Out of School Club staff have noticed a number of parents doing this before and after school. As a reminder, the playground gate will be open for OOSC parents from 7.30am to 8.10am. After 8.10am, children should be taken to the main entrance for OOSC. Similarly, at the end of the day, children should be collected from the main entrance if picking up before 4pm. The gate will be open from 4pm to 5.55pm when OOSC closes.

Lifting your child over the wall or over gates suggests to them that this is acceptable to do and may lead to them trying this at playtimes or lunchtimes. Equally, allowing children to see you jumping over gives them the same message.

**Dogs** - Just a reminder that dogs are not allowed on our premises except for assistance dogs. This includes carried dogs. Please can people coming to collect from OOSC refrain from bringing dogs into the playground.

**Attendance** - It has been lovely to meet some parents this week who we had invited in to discuss their child's attendance. Having an understanding of the difficulties that some families face is important to us as sometimes we can offer simple solutions which help the child and family to be able to improve punctuality and attendance. We obviously monitor all children's attendance regularly and invite those in whose attendance has dipped or whose attendance is causing us concern. Please don't feel though that you have to wait until this point for us to offer help. If there are ever circumstances that you feel we may be able to help with, please get in touch with Miss Bayliss in the office as she can offer advice and support.

**Buns sponsorship** - We have a sponsor to purchase the additional buns next week but after that do not have any sponsorship. If you would like to sponsor the buns for £40 either as a family, an anonymous donor, or a business, please let myself or Mr Laycock know.

**Wildlife Area** - We are pausing our Wildlife area time for classes until the weather improves.
