Important information for next week

It is our Walk and Wheel week next week. We have entered into the national competition to see if we can be the school with the highest proportion of children walking or wheeling to school. If you live too far away, please consider parking further away from school and walking or wheeling from there to school so that your child's journey counts for us! We will be collecting data in each class and collating it as a school to see what proportion of children actively travel to school. I'm hoping that some staff might even try it!

Other information

Offline challenge - Our offline challenge for this week is one of our life skills challenges. We would like all children to learn how to make a bed. Obviously, this will be dependent on the child's age. A younger child may learn how to straighten their pillow and pull their quilt over the rest of the bed. Our older children could learn how to change their bedding so that they can put a pillowcase on and change their quilt cover. The Year 5 children find this hugely challenging when they are expected to do it on their residential so it would be good practice for children from Y4 upwards! Please don't forget to send photos to your child's classteacher so that the class can earn pride points.

Book fair - Thank you to all those families that purchased a book from the book fair. The commission that we earn from this helps us to buy new books for school. Your support is always appreciated.
