Special mention of the week!

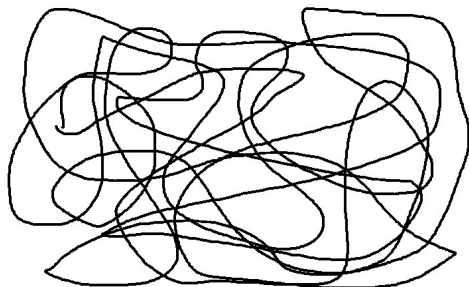

Offline challenge - This week, our offline challenge involves children being careful and thorough as well as being creative. After the pattern is formed, they should colour each section that has been created taking care to stay within the lines and colour in neatly and thoroughly so that each section is a bold colour. Talent show - The choir is going to perform at the Talent Show as an interlude to the other acts. Please can parents of choir members let Miss Kitson know if your child is not available to perform on 20th May in the evening.

Victoria's tree - There is a very special tree in the middle of the circular bench outside Sweden, The Nest and Y3 classrooms. It is dedicated to someone who committed time, energy and care to the Withinfields Community as our chair of governors. Please can parents waiting for children coming out of these classes make sure that little ones don't pull at the branches.

Out of School Club and Nursery charges from September 2026 - The Governors have decided to increase our charges for OOSC and additional Nursery sessions from September. This is due to increased staffing costs. These prices per session have not increased for a number of years.

From September:

Morning OOSC will be £6 per session (this has not changed)

After school OOSC will be £10 per session

Nursery additional sessions of 3 hours will be £17.43 and will be reviewed each September to remain in line with funding received for funded sessions.

Collecting from OOSC - If you are collecting from Out of School Club and have a dog, please can you ensure that you keep the dog away from the gate while you are waiting for your child to be brought to you. This is so that other children, who may be wary of dogs, can leave safely.

Y5 Sports Leaders - We have arranged some training for children who would like to be sports leaders in the playground. We are offering this training to children in Y5 so that they can carry out this role next year at lunchtimes. Children need to apply for this job using our Pupil Application Form and details about the job will be made available for Y5 children to access. For further information, please ask the Y5 staff.
