Important information

We break up today for half term. It's a busy half term coming up. I've tried to list all the major events that are happening but there are bound to be other dates that come up as the term progresses so please keep an eye on the diary dates list each week.

Other information

Offline challenge - We challenge children to investigate patterns this week, especially as there is due to be lots of sunshine! Children may want to stand on a particular spot and get someone to draw around their shadow each hour to see how their shadow appears in a different place each time. Similarly, children might want to draw around the same object each hour to see how the length of shadows changes as the day progresses. Younger children might want to draw around shadows or different objects and see if someone else can guess what the object was!



Bikes and scooters - I have been informed by a parent that some children who are coming to school on their scooters and bikes are travelling at speed down the pavement and crossing roads without checking fully for traffic. This is obviously dangerous for themselves but also for the pedestrians using the pavement.

Please can I also remind parents that children should be wearing a helmet if they are travelling on a scooter or bike. We have lots of children arriving at school without helmets. I will lead an assembly next half term outlining the importance of wearing a helmet when riding on a bike or scooter.
