World Book Day

Our next challenge for you to start preparing for in readiness of our World Book Day celebrations is to think of times where you 'read without realising'! We will be asking you to send in photos of adults or children in your house doing this so that we can make a display in school. Please talk to your children about all the things that you do in a day which involve some sort of reading – checking bus times, scrolling your phone, playing games, reading recipes, the list is endless!

Medication in school

At the moment, it seems like Mrs McCulloch has a full time job in giving doses of medication at various points in the day so it seemed like a good time to remind parents of the systems for medication in school.

If your child has been prescribed medication that they need to have administered during the school day, please always bring it to the school office so that the appropriate forms can be completed giving us permission to administer the medication. Please do not hand it to classteachers or other staff on cloakroom doors.

If your child is recovering from an operation or other procedure or injury and they are likely to need pain medication, we are willing to administer this as long as you have completed a form at the school office.

In the event that your child becomes a little under the weather during the school day (e.g. toothache, headache etc), we may contact you to see if you would like us to provide paracetamol medication in the first instance rather than asking for them to be picked up. We keep stocks of medication in school for this purpose.

Half Term Activities

There are some leaflets in the lobby and information was posted on ClassDojo this week about activities during the half term holidays for children eligible for Free School Meals. The activities are free and include a meal at lunchtime.

World Book Day

This is coming up at the beginning of March. We are going to invite children to dress up but, instead of families spending lots of money on costumes and outfits to dress up as book characters, we want children to choose a word to dress up as. Hopefully this means that they can use items that they already have. For example, they may want to choose a word that represents a colour or pattern e.g. camouflaged and find clothes which match this. They can also choose a more adventurous word where they can be more creative about their outfit. There are some ideas at the end of the newsletter. With millions of words to choose from, I can't wait to see what each child chooses!

Nursery intakes

The deadline for completing an expression of interest form for the nursery intake in September (children who are 3 on or before 31st August) is 24th April. We will still accept forms after this but they will be allocated places after the people who have handed forms in by 24th April.
